



TRAVEL DIRECTIONS

BY ROAD

From the A49 at Ludlow (half an hour)

Take the A4113 (signposted Leintwardine and Knighton) at Bromfield, opposite the 'Clive and Cookhouse' restaurant 2 miles north of Ludlow.

After about 4 miles you will pass the 'Jolly Frog' pub/restaurant on your right. A few hundred yards later take a turn to the right signposted Clungunford and Craven Arms, then turn right at the T junction.

Take the next left signposted Hopton Heath and go right at the T junction (thatched cottage). As the road bears to the right at Hopton Heath take a left turn over the railway bridge and then immediately left again signposted Hopton Castle and Obley.

Go through Hopton Castle and keep on the same road. You will travel up a steep bank, through a coniferous plantation, a sharp bend to the right and then a sharp bend to the left uphill. The road levels out and then drops down, bends to the right and then brings you to a T junction. Turn left then immediately right and the entrance to Ecocabin is under a large sycamore tree opposite the Victorian Methodist Chapel.

From the A49 at Craven Arms (20 minutes)

Take the B4368 for Clun at the roundabout by the Craven Arms Hotel. Turn left at Long Meadows End signposted Leintwardine and Clungunford. Keep on the same road, through Clungunford and then turn right at a nasty junction in Hopton Heath signposted Clun and Bishops Castle. Go over the railway bridge and then turn immediately left signposted Hopton Castle and Obley.

Go through Hopton Castle and keep on the same road. You will travel up a steep bank, through a coniferous plantation, a sharp bend to the right and then a sharp bend to the left uphill. The road levels out and then drops down, bends to the right and then brings you to a T junction. Turn left then immediately right and the entrance to Ecocabin is under a large sycamore tree opposite the Victorian Methodist Chapel.

From Knighton (15 minutes)

Take the A488 for Clun and Bishops Castle (past the railway station). When you get to a small hamlet called New Invention turn right (nasty junction) for Chapel Lawn and Bucknell. Go through Chapel Lawn and after the bridge on leaving the village take a left turn up a steep bank signposted Obley. Keep on this road past a farm at Pentre Hodre and if the road appears to fork keep to the right, until you reach a Victorian Methodist Chapel on your right. Turn left and the entrance to Ecocabin is immediately on your left under a large sycamore tree.

From Clun (10 minutes)

If you are travelling up the hill towards Knighton after crossing the narrow bridge take the left turn directly in front of the church (Vicarage Road). Then take the next right signposted Woodside. Keep on this road until the view opens out to your right. The road then bears to the left and goes down a steep straight hill. At the bottom keep to the left of the grass 'island'. When you get to a junction with a Victorian Methodist Chapel in front of you, the entrance to Ecocabin is on your right under a large sycamore tree.
